

PETITION AND COURT'S ORDER

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:-

The Petition of Andrew H.

Albaugh of Frederick County respectfully shows unto your Honors:-

1. That on the 28th day of April 1886 a certain John L. Zimmerman and Emma C. Zimmerman, his wife, by their deed of trust did convey unto your Petitioner, as trustee for the benefit of the creditors of the said John L. Zimmerman, all the property and estate of him the said John L. Zimmerman, as will fully appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed of trust herewith filed as part hereof marked "Exhibit No. 1".
2. That your Petitioner has accepted said trust and has filed his duly approved bond in the Clerk's Office of your Honorable Court conditioned for the faithful discharge of the trust reposed in him by said deed, as required by law, and is about to proceed upon the execution of his duties as such trustee.
3. That among the assets of said trust estate is the lease of a farm which will expire on the 1st day of April 1897 and a home place now occupied by said John L. Zimmerman, upon both of which places preparations have been made for a Spring corn crop, and the same has been partly planted, and the balance of the ground is nearly all prepared and ready to receive the seed; that the season for corn planting is at hand and that it would be to the benefit and advantage of said trust estate to have said corn crop fully planted, attended and harvested.
