

I hereby annul and set aside the bequest of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to my executors as set forth in my said will, to be deposited in their names as Trustees, \$7500 in the Valley Savings Bank, of Middletown, Maryland, and \$7500 in the Central Trust Company of Maryland, the income to be paid to my wife, Mattie E. Kefauver, during the term of her natural life and after her death to be given and bequeathed as in my said will set forth; it being my intention that the foregoing bequest of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the benefit of my wife, and the distribution of the same as hereinbefore provided after her death is to be in lieu of the said total sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars devised and bequeathed as aforesaid in my said last will and Testament.

In addition to the specific legacies mentioned in my said will to be paid out of my estate before distribution, I give and bequeath the following, the same to be paid before the distribution of the rest and residue among the children of my deceased brothers and my brothers and sisters which were living at the time of the writing of my will, to wit:-

To my sister, Lizzie May Routzahn, I give and bequeath the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) as an appreciation for the services she rendered me during the early part of my life.

To The Hoffman Orphan Home, located near Littlestown, Pennsylvania, I give and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the benefit of said home.

I also will and direct that my brothers, Millard F. Kefauver and Oliver H. Kefauver, shall each be paid the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) in full for their services as executors under my said will, instead of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each as provided in said will.

I hereby ratify and confirm my said Will and Testament in all respect except as changed or modified by the provisions of this Codicil.
