RECEIVED of The Potomac Edison Company, \$ one in consideration of which we hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate, and maintain its lines for the transmission of electrical current and telephone, including the necessary secondary and service wires, poles, cables, and fixtures, over and along the property which we, own or in which we have any interest, said pole line to be located on & across property of undersigned in a southerly direction from the Lewistown-Creagerstown road to the adjoining property on the south belonging to Mshrl H. Ramsburg, in Lewistown Election District of Frederick County, State of Maryland, to permit the attachment of wires of any other Company or person; to trim and keep trimmed any trees along side said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least twenty-five feet, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires, said sum being received in fully payment therefor.

Poles to be relocated to conform with future building operations when necessary.
