

the Frederick and Creagerstown Public Road across the Monocacy at Link's
Ford, being about one-half mile East of said Frederick and Creagerstown
Public Road, and about 1½ miles North from Utica Mills; being same-
property conveyed to Benton Stull by (1) deed from Elijah T. Stull
and wife, dated April 23, 1908, recorded in Liber S.T.H. 282, folio
543, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, (2) deed from
Grayson Stull and wife, et al, dated November 7, 1929, recorded in
