TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The answer of the Woodsboro Savings Bank of Frederick County, Maryland, to the bill of complaint filed against it in this cause, respectfully says:

1st. That it neither admits nor denies the matters and things set forth in the First, Second, Fourth, and Fifth paragraphs of the bill of complaint.

2nd. That, this defendant, answering the Third paragraph of the bill of complaint, admits that the said property of Benton Stull is subject to a judgment of the Woodsboro Savings Bank for \$13,500.00, being No. 171 Trials, September Term, 1929, and recorded in Transcript Docket 22, folio 326, upon which a Writ of Scire Facias has been issued, being No. 15 Originals, September Term, 1941.

3rd. That, further answering the bill of complaint, this defendant, desires to reserve and maintain all its rights, powers and remedies under its judgment aforesaid, but in so far as it is able, consents to the passage of a decree of your Honorable Court for the sale of all the property mentioned in the said bill of complaint, free of its lien, on condition that its lien shall be preserved against the proceeds of sale, and it shall
