STATE OF MARYLAND, FREDERICK COUNTY, TO-WIT:

I hereby certify that on this 6th day of August, in the year Nineteen Hundred and Forty-two, personally appeared before me the Subscriber, a Notary Public of the State of Maryland, in and for the County aforesaid, Martha Aquillard, a party plaintiff to the above entitled cause, who made oath in due form of law that John Ceasar and Edythe Ceasar, his wife, and Oscar Ceasar and Daisy Ceasar, his wife, are not in the military service of the United States of America. She sets forth the following facts in support of that contention.

FIRST: That Oscar Ceasar is married to Daisy Ceasar and to the best of her knowledge is deferred on account of dependency; that the said Oscar Ceasar is about thirty years of age.

SECOND: That John Ceasar is married to Edythe Ceasar and that to the best of her knowledge is deferred on account of dependency; that the said John Ceasar is over forty years of age.

THIRD: That the said John Ceasar and Edythe Ceasar, his wife, and Oscar Ceasar and Daisy Ceasar, his wife, are residents of the City and State of New York, and that your affiant corresponds with the said parties and that from said correspondence knows that these parties are not in the military service of the United States.

FOURTH: That your affiant has read the affidavit made by Harry Ceasar, filed in this case by the plaintiff and begged to be taken as a part thereof; that your affiant knows the ~~same~~ and facts stated in said affidavit to be true.
