TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of John Remsberg and Bertha Remsberg, his wife, by Robert E. Clapp, Jr., their solicitor, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

FIRST: That Henry T. Remsberg, late of Frederick County, State of Maryland, departed this life on or about the 21st day of July, 1942, seized and possessed of certain parcels of ground comprising a farm of approximately 158 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres, of land, more or less, situate, lying and being in Middletown Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, improved with the usual and customary farm buildings and being more particularly described as follows:
