Stier, Marsaline Stier, J. Hugh Stier, and the heirs of Katie S. Nichols, brother and sisters of the whole blood, and the heirs of Frederick A. Stier, the heirs of Henry Clay Stier, and the heirs of Charlotte Stier Dulaney, brothers and sister of the half blood; who predeceased the said Nannie F. Stier; that the said Marsaline Stier died July 30, 1934, intestate, leaving as her heirs at law and next of kin, Alma D. Stier, J. Hugh Stier, and the heirs of Katie S. Nichols, brother and sister of the whole blood, and the heirs of Frederick A. Stier, the heirs of Henry Clay, and the heirs of Charlotte Stier Dulaney, brothers and sister of the half blood; that the said J. Hugh Stier died October 6, 1936, testate, and in his will he directed that his estate be divided according to law as though he had died intestate, a certified copy of his will being filed in this cause as an exhibit; that on February 22, 1946, the said Alma D. Stier died intestate, leaving as her heirs at law and next of kin, the heirs of Katie S. Nichols and the heirs of J. Hugh Stier, sister and brother of the whole blood, and the heirs of Frederick A. Stier, the heirs of Henry Clay Stier, and the heirs of Charlotte Stier Dulaney, sister and brothers of the half blood.
