TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Walter K. Buhrman and Edith Buhrman, his wife, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That heretofore, to-wit, on the 13th day of February, 1937, your Petitioners filed their Bill of Complaint in this cause alleging the death of Elmer E. THIRD: That the Writ of Subpoena issued against Martin Buhrman and Irene Buhrman, his wife, has been returned "non sunt" and your Petitioners have been informed and verily believe and aver that the said Martin Buhrman left Washington County and his whereabouts are unknown but to the best information and belief, the said Martin Buhrman is a non-resident of the State of Maryland, and that his said wife, Irene Buhrman, if living, is a non-resident of the State of Maryland, although your Petitioners are further informed from other sources that the said Irene Buhrman is now dead.

FOURTH: That your Petitioners have caused the Order of Publication to be issued notifying the non-resident defendants of the object and substance of the Bill of Complaint filed in this cause, which said Order of Publication has expired:
