

Will Records in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, in Liber B.C. No. 2, Folio 60, a certified copy of said Will being filed herewith, as a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit E"; that by said Last Will and Testament, the said Charles E. Trail gave and devised unto his sons, Charles B. Trail and Henry Trail, in Trust for his daughter Florence Trail, with Power of Appointment to his said daughter Florence Trail, the farm first hereinbefore described under sub-paragraph "A"; and that the said Charles E. Trail further gave and devised unto his said sons, Charles B. Trail and Henry Trail, in Trust for his daughter Bertha Trail, with Power of Appointment to his said daughter Bertha Trail, the farm hereinbefore described under sub-paragraph "B".

THIRD: That Florence Trail departed this life on or about the 21st day of April, 1944, leaving a Last Will and Testament dated the 3rd day of October, 1924, and duly recorded among the Will Records in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, in Liber R.L.L. No. 1, Folio 550, a certified copy of which said Will is filed herewith, as a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit F", in which said Will the said Florence Trail exercised the Power of Appointment given her in the Will of her father, Charles E. Trail, by directing that at the death of her sister, Bertha Trail (who predeceased the said Florence Trail) all the rest and residue of her estate be distributed to her seven nieces and one nephew, hereinafter named, share and share alike.

FOURTH: That Bertha Trail departed this life on or about the 5th day of May, 1940, leaving a Last Will and Testament dated the 10th day of March, 1936, and recorded among the Will Records in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, in Liber J.H. No. 1, Folio 589, a certified copy of which said Will is filed herewith, as a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit G", in which said Will the said Bertha Trail exercised the Power
