ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to provide for the sale of certain real estate of which Nellie Beacht, late of Frederick County, died seized and possessed, and for the distribution of the proceeds derived therefrom among the parties entitled according to their respective interests.

The BILL states in substance: That Nellie Beacht, late of Frederick County, Maryland, widow of Edward Thomas Beacht who predeceased her, departed this life intestate on or about November 25, 1941 seized and possessed of a tract or parcel of ground, improved by a dwelling house thereon known as 117 West C Street in the town of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, and being the same real estate which was conveyed unto Edward Thomas Beacht and Nellie Beacht, his wife, by Deed from Americus A. Wenner, et al, dated the 15th day of May, 1920, and recorded in Liber 333, folio 418, etc., one of the Land Records of Frederick County; that the said Nellie Beacht left as her heirs-at-law the following: Elmer Beacht, a son who intermarried with one Caroline Beacht, and who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland, residing at R.F.D. 1, Somerville, New Jersey, Evelyn Young, a daughter who intermarried with Wendell Young, who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland,
