This Deed, made this 9th day of August in the year Nineteen Hundred and twenty one, by us, Mary E. Schroyer and Evers W. Schroyer, her husband, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland.

WITNESSETH:- That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) dollars to us paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the said Mary E. Schroyer and Evers W. Schroyer, her husband, do grant and convey unto Jacob H. Flook and Virgie I. Flook, his wife, of Frederick County, Maryland, the perpetual right to use the water from the spring located near the dwelling house on the premises occupied by us, the said grantors, which was conveyed by deed dated the 26th day of March, A. D. 1904, by John Scadden, and intended to be recorded among the land records of Frederick County, prior to the recording of this deed. Together with the perpetual right of ingress and egress to the said spring of water, to lay the necessary pipe to carry water from said spring to the property now owned and occupied by the said Jacob E. Flook and Virgie I. Flook, his wife, and to enter upon the said premises for the purpose of doing anything necessary for the maintenance and keeping in repair of said pipe line.
