TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The Answer of MARGUERITE L. CHAMBERS, widow, incorrectly designated MARY CHAMBERS in a copy of Bill of Complaint in the above-entitled case that has been exhibited to her, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That she admits the allegations of paragraph First of said Bill of Complaint regarding kinship of the following, namely: Laura B. Arnold and Editha A. Arnold, surviving children of Mary Ann Wiener Arnold; Sue Zepp, widow, Mary Miller, Marian Miller and Eleanor Miller, children of the late J. Nicholas Miller; T. Denton Miller, Jr., whose wife is Viola McAvoy Miller, Rosa Miller Hanafee, whose husband is Frank J. Hanafee, May Miller Owings, whose husband is Thaddeus C. Owings and James Rogers Miller, whose wife is Lee Miller, surviving children of the late T. Denton Miller; and Marguerite L. Chambers (incorrectly named as Mary Chambers, widow, Cora L. Forrest, widow and Emma L. Wright, widow, surviving children of the late Mary Jane Linthicum. However, this Respondent has no personal knowledge and neither admits nor denies the allegations regarding kinship of four named defendants, namely: Margaret Wiener, Thomas Wiener, Nora Gertrude Rogers, widow, and Catherine Hardy.

SECOND: That she admits there are at least two tracts of land in Frederick County of which Bertha Wiener died seized and possessed, and possibly other lands not specified in said Bill, and answering paragraphs Second and Third of said Bill of Complaint, she admits such allegations and consents to the passage of a decree as prayed, hereby submitting her rights to the protection of this Honorable Court.
