

PETITION AND COURT'S ORDER AUTHORIZING SALE OF REAL ESTATE

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Harry A. Eaton, Trustee for Virginia A. Eaton, incompetent, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That by a decree of your Honorable Court passed in this cause on the 18th day of March, 1947, Virginia A. Eaton was declared to be incompetent to manage her estate, and your Petitioner was appointed Trustee to take charge of and manage the property of the said Virginia A. Eaton.

2. That pursuant to said decree your Petitioner has duly qualified as Trustee aforesaid by filing in the Office of the Clerk of your Honorable Court his duly approved bond in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) with the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company as corporate surety.

3. That your Petitioner as Trustee renews the prayer for relief set forth in the petition heretofore filed in this cause on the 4th day of March, 1947, by your Petitioner as next friend of the said Virginia A. Eaton:

"That your Honorable Court will pass a decree ordering the sale of the interest of the said Virginia A. Eaton in and to the real estate set forth in Exhibits "Nos. 3 and 4", and that the proceeds arising therefrom may be invested in stocks or other property, or in mortgages on real estate, or in other safe securities as your Honorable Court may deem most advantageous to the said Virginia A. Eaton, incompetent.
