FINAL DECREE

This case having been submitted, and the proceedings therein having been read and duly considered by the Court, it is thereupon this 9th day of March, 1947, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, and by the authority thereof, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that ALL RIGHTS OF REDEMPTION of John White, also known as John White of Benjamin, and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property located in Urbana District, Frederick County, Maryland, consisting of twenty-nine acres, one rood and thirty perches of land, more or less, assessed as fifty-eight acres of land in the name of John White; and all rights of redemption of the unknown owner of property located in Urbana District, Frederick County, Maryland, consisting of twenty-nine acres, one rood and thirty perches of land, more or less, assessed as fifty-eight acres of land in the name of John White, and being a part of a tract of land known as "Foul Play"; and all rights of redemption of the said unknown owner's heirs, devisees and personal representatives, and their or any of their heirs, devisees, executors, administrators, grantees, assigns, or successors in right, title and interest, BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY FORECLOSED.

And it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, be and he is hereby directed to execute a deed in fee simple to Edward D. Storm, plaintiff in this cause and the holder of the Certificate of Sale, upon payment to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer as aforesaid, of the balance of the purchase price due on account of said property, together with all taxes and interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale on the 14th of April, 1947.
