- (a) A son, Harry C. Dorcus, who intermarried with Lola A. Dorcus.
- (b) A daughter, Grace I. Staley, who intermarried with Irving E. Staley.
- (c) A daughter, Mae D. Gross, who intermarried with Howard A. Gross.
- (d) A son, Roy M. Dorcus, who intermarried with Mildred D. Dorcus.

SIXTH: That the said Amy L. Eichelberger is a widow and an adult, the said Russell G. Eichelberger having predeceased her with title to the aforesaid lot or parcel of ground vesting in her as the survivor.

That the Complainants are filing this proceeding to protect themselves as owner of the legal title from being disturbed in their possession, and from being harassed by suits in regard to their title by persons setting up unjust and illegal pretensions and claims and that they do not have an adequate remedy at law.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That this Honorable Court will decree that the title in fee to said lot of ground of your Orators, A. Earl Bussard and Evelyn L. Bussard, his wife, may be established and confirmed and that the said doubts and clouds as to the validity of such title may be removed by the appointment of a trustee to execute a Deed granting and conveying all the right, title and interest, both at law and in equity, of William F. Cover to A. Earl Bussard and Evelyn L. Bussard, his wife, as tenants by the entireties.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to Amy L. Eichelberger, C. Harry Dorcus and Lola A. Dorcus, his wife, of Woodsboro; Nellie C.
