

3. That upon payment of the interest of Ruth G. Roderick Stone as may be directed by your Honorable Court, an Order be passed decreeing and declaring said Mortgage indebtedness paid and satisfied, and a Trustee be appointed to cancel and release said Mortgage note and Mortgage executed by your Complainants to William Mc. Roderick on the 13th day of April, 1926, on the Land Records of Frederick County.

4. That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as their case may require.
