TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition and Report of Sales of Leslie N. Coblentz, Trustee in the above entitled cause, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

(1) That pursuant to the provisions of a decree of your Honorable Court dated the 2nd day of December, 1940, the Trustee in said decree named gave bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty designated in said order, which bond was duly approved by the Clerk of the Court and filed as required by law.

(2) That after giving said bond, the said Trustee advertised the property hereinafter described to be sold at public sale, as appears by the Printer's Certificate filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit "No. 1", which said advertisement of sale was published in "The Valley Register", a newspaper published and circulated in Frederick County, Maryland, for three successive weeks prior to the day of sale, and also in "The Frederick Post", of Frederick, Maryland, giving notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale as required by said decree.
