TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

Your Orators and Oratrix, complaining, say:

1. That a certain Catherine K. Strailman, whose husband had predeceased her, died at Frederick County, Maryland, intestate, on or about the 10th. day of June, 1902, and left surviving her the following named children, as all of and her only heirs at law and next of kin, viz:

(a) A daughter, Elsie J. Strailman, who never married and left no child or children, who died on the 3rd day of March, 1941, leaving a last Will and Testament, which has been duly admitted to probate by the Orphans' Court for Frederick County, Maryland, and that D.
