I, SIDNEY SAPPINGTON, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say:-

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter, Emma I. Trundle, for and during her natural life only, the following houses and tracts of land, namely, my farm lying in Johnsville district and now tenanted by William B. Grimes, my house and lot situated in Libertytown and now occupied by H. Clayton Trundle, together with the land attached thereto, also my houses and lots situated on east North Street in Liberty-town and formerly owned by the late Mrs. Thomas Brightwell, all of said property being situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and at and upon the death of my said daughter, Emma I. Trundle, I give and bequeath the aforesaid houses and tracts of land to the child or children of the said Emma I. Trundle, in equal shares, and in case the said Emma I. Trundle leave no child or children surviving her, then I give and bequeath the aforesaid houses and tracts of land to my legal heirs.

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter, Emma I. Trundle, the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son, Richard F. Sappington, for and during his natural life only, the following tracts of land, namely, my farm lying in Woodville district, and now tenanted by Gerard Kreimer, my two wood lots lying in Woodville district, my farm lying in Johnsville district and now tenanted by Clinton Metcalfe, my wood lot in Piney Hill and purchased from Andrew Baker, and my pasture lots situated on North Street in Libertytown, and west of the town branch, all of said property being situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and at and upon the death of my said son, Richard F. Sappington, I give and bequeath the aforesaid tracts of land to the child or children of the said Richard F. Sappington in equal shares, and in case the said Richard F. Sappington leave no child or children surviving him, then I will and devise the aforesaid tracts of land to my legal heirs.

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter, Adelaide E. Hammond, for and during her natural life only, the following tracts of land, namely, my farm lying in Woodsboro District and now tenanted by William H. Adams, my farm lying near Double Pipe Creek in Carroll County and now tenanted
