My name is H. Walton White and I am one of the Complainants in this cause and reside at Washington, North Carolina. My wife's name is Tillie H. White. Mary I. White, my aunt, and a sister of Ellen M. White, died January 19, 1933.

By Mr. Felton:

Q When did Ellen M. White die, if you know?

A June 14, 1939.

Q What relation was Ellen M. White to you?

A Aunt.

Q Did she die intestate or testate?

A Intestate.

Q Has her personal property been administered upon?

A Yes.

Q Who were the heirs of Ellen M. White, if you know?

A Nieces and nephews only.

Q She didn't leave surviving her any parents or brothers or sisters?

A No, sir.

Q Do you know about when he died?

A I would say twelve years ago.

Q Did he leave any children surviving him?

A Yes, Richard's children were Margaret E. Bristow, adult; E. Kathryn Bristow, Infant; Millicent Bristow, Infant, and Rich-
