In the name of God, Amen, I, Mary E. Walter, of Frederick County, State of Maryland, do make, ordain and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, to-wit;

After the payment by my Executor hereinafter named of all my just debts and funeral expenses, I give, devise and bequeath unto my Executor hereinafter named to be held in trust for my grandson Claude W. Seiss until he shall have become twenty one (21) years of age and then to be turned over to him as his own absolutely the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00). I also give, devise and bequeath unto my Executor hereinafter named to be held in trust for my grandson Charles Allen Seiss during his life, the income to be paid his father, Samuel E. Seiss, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and at his death this said sum to go to my grandson Claude W. Seiss or in case of his death before the death of Charles Allen Seiss to go to my son, William F. Walter. I also give, devise and bequeath unto my Executor hereinafter named to be held in trust for my grandson Charles Dorsey Walter until he shall have become twenty one (21) years of age and then to be turned over to him as his own absolutely the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00). These said sums to be held in trust by my Executor as above stated and deposited on interest in The Thurmont Bank of Thurmont, Maryland.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property, whether real, personal and mixed, and whether now owned or hereafter acquired by me, I give, devise and bequeath in fee simple unto my son William F. Walter.

Lastly, I constitute and appoint my son William F. Walter to be Executor of this my last will and testament with full power to sell and convert my property into cash, hereby revoke and annulling all other and former wills by me heretofore ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.
