The bill of complaint of Stanley J. Meadows, Katharine Meadows, Mary Evelyn Brown and Walter A. Brown, respectfully represents:

1. That a certain John E. Meadows, whose name is also written J. Eugene Meadows, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was, at the time of his death, seized and possessed of certain real estate located in Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, being all that lot of land and the improvements thereon, fronting on the South side of Potomac Street, for a distance of 114 feet, and being the same real estate conveyed to him from H. Kieffer DeLauter, Trustee, by deed dated July 14, 1919, and recorded in Liber No. 328, at folio 416, one of the land records for said Frederick County, and a certified copy of said deed is filed herewith as part of this bill of complaint, and marked "Exhibit A".
