7. That your Complainants are advised, aver and charge
under the circumstances hereinbefore enumerated they have no
adequate remedy at law and that they are entitled to invoke the
jurisdiction of your Honorable Court to quiet title to the real
estate mentioned and described herein and to remove the cloud
therefrom.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That your Honorable Court may pass a decree quieting
title to the real estate mentioned and described in this Bill of
Complaint in Jane Anne Smith, widow and devisee of Wilson Porter
Smith, and Olive Jean Brown, daughter and devisee of Wilson Porter
Smith, the Complainants herein, and removing the cloud from the
title thereof.

2. That your Honorable Court may declare the Complain-
ants, Jane Anne Smith, widow and devisee of Wilson Porter Smith,
and Olive Jean Brown, daughter and devisee of Wilson Porter Smith,
to be the owners in fee simple of the real estate mentioned and
described in the Bill of Complaint as life tenant and remainderman
respectively.

3. That these Complainants may have such other and fur-
ther relief as the nature and equity of their cause may require.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto these Complaints
an Order of Publication against the said Edward H. Schaffer,
demanding and warning him ~~or them and each of them~~ to be and appear
in this Court on some day certain to be named therein and to answer
the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed
herein.
