

folio 37, among the Land Records of Frederick County. It is further stated that the said Edward H. Schaffer has since removed from Frederick County leaving behind him neither relatives nor information as to his whereabouts known to the Complainants.

The Bill of Complaint prays that a decree may be passed quieting title to the real estate mentioned and described therein in Jane Anne Smith, widow and devisee of Wilson Porter Smith, and Olive Jean Brown, daughter and devisee of Wilson Porter Smith, and that the said Jane Anne Smith and Olive Jean Brown may be declared to be the owners in fee simple of the real estate mentioned and described as life tenant and remainderman respectively, and for general relief and process.

It is thereupon this 3rd day of March, 1955 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, ORDERED that the Complainants herein give notice to the said Edward H. Schaffer, a non-resident defendant, of the object and substance of this Bill by causing a copy of the same to be published in some newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 2nd day of April 1955, commanding him to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 1st day of April 1955, and show cause, if any, that and why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
