

"EXHIBIT WILL"

I, Alfred Roberts of Frederick County, State of Maryland, do hereby devise and bequeath after my debts and funeral expenses are paid, to my wife Elizabeth Roberts, during her natural life, all my real and personal property and after her death, I hereby give to my son Francis P. Roberts, two town lots situated in Libertytown Frederick County, Maryland, and adjoining the colored peoples grave-yard, and should my son Francis P. Roberts be able to improve said lots by building thereon during the natural life, of my wife Elizabeth Roberts, I request my wife, Elizabeth Roberts to permit my son Francis P. Roberts to have the use of one half of one of the lots for said purpose.

After the death of my said wife I hereby give to my son Albert G. Roberts the lot of ground purchased of Mrs. Margaret Poole and situated on the Middle Road, and if my said son should be able to build thereon during the natural life of my said wife I request my said wife to permit my son Albert G. Roberts to have the use of one quarter of an acre of the northern portion of the said lot for the said purpose.

After the death of my said wife Elizabeth Roberts, I direct my son James H. Roberts to sell two acres of my land on the Woodsboro road and adjoining Franklin Eichleberger's land and give twenty dollars to my deceased daughter Elizabeths children, and the balance of the money to be equally divided between the children of my deceased daughter Clementine.

After the death of my said wife, I give to my son Albert G. Roberts one acre of land back of the colored peoples colored grave-yard and adjoining the land of Franklin Eichleberger.

After the death of my said wife I give to my son James H. Roberts the buildings the balance of the land and all my personal property.

I hereby appoint my wife Elizabeth Roberts Executrix of this my last will and testament.
