TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Charles L. Thompson, by Stewart Hobbs Brown, his solicitor respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court.

FIRST: That by an Order of your Honorable Court dated the 3rd day of December, 1954, Charles L. Thompson was appointed Committee to take charge, care for and manage the property of the said Mary V. Thompson, Incompetent, under the jurisdiction of this Court, after he shall have given bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of \$1,000.00. Said bond having been filed and approved by the Clerk.

SECOND: That John F. Thompson died, intestate, on or about the 31st day of December 1930, survived by his widow, the said Mary V. Thompson, Incompetent; a daughter Susie B. Thompson, now Susie B. Culler, by a previous marriage; and the following named children by Mary V. Thompson, a son, John W. Thompson; a daughter Lydia G. Thompson, now Lydia G. Maple, widow; a son, George R. Thompson; a son, Thomas F. Thompson; a son, Charles L. Thompson and a daughter Anna V. Thompson, now Anna V. Lawson.

THIRD: That John F. Thompson, by a deed dated June 18, 1913, acquired from Charles A. Poole, et ux., a parcel of real estate fronting on Washington Street, in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, and recorded in Liber 306, folio 247, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland; that John F. Thompson and Mary V. Thompson, his wife, by a deed dated January 25, 1915, acquired from Philip T. Kuhn, et ux., et al., a parcel of real estate adjoining the above mentioned property, and recorded in Liber 328, folio 554, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland; that John F. Thompson and Mary V. Thompson, his wife, by a deed dated September 22, 1917, acquired from John L. Bradshaw, et al., a parcel of real estate also adjoining the first mentioned parcel above, and recorded in Liber 328, folio 554, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, being parts of lots #9 and #10 and the unnumbered lot in the rear of said lots as shown on a plat recorded in Liber #300, folio 540, etc., one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland.
