 FRIEND OF MARY V. THOMPSON :

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Charles L. Thompson, Committee, by Stewart Hobbs Brown, his solicitor, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That by an Order of your Honorable Court dated the 3rd day of December, 1954, Charles L. Thompson was appointed Committee to take charge, care for and manage the property of the said Mary V. Thompson, Incompetent, under the jurisdiction of this Court, after he shall have given bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of \$1,000.00. Said bond having been filed and approved by the Clerk.

SECOND: That in the course of a title examination, by the attorney for the prospective mortgagee, of the property located at 239 Washington Street, Frederick, Maryland, in which the aforesaid Mary V. Thompson, Incompetent, has an interest; in the course of examining the papers in this cause, being No. 17984 Equity, some doubt has been raised by the attorney as to whether the jurisdictional requirements of Section 135, Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Ed.) have been met; by a showing that the alleged incompetent had been attended by a medical doctor or an attending neuropsychiatrist within ten days before the filing of the petition, as required by the Article and Section aforesaid.

THIRD: That Dr. Stephen Lee Magness, by a Supplemental Certificate, with his affidavit attached, has certified that he attended and examined the said Mary V. Thompson, on November 5, 1954, which is within 10 days of November 12, 1954, the original date of the filing of the petition in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland. Said paper writing being marked "EXHIBIT Supplemental Certificate", attached hereto and prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That the Court will pass an Order, re-affirming the Order of the Court dated the 3rd day of December, 1954, in No. 17984 Equity.
2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
