To The End Therefor:

(1) That the said Charles L. Thompson, Committee, be authorized and empowered to sell all of the right, title and interest of the parties to the deed dated February 8th, 1955, in and to the aforesaid property of John F. Thompson and Mary V. Thompson, both deceased, to B. E. Walker, Jr., and Audrey M. Walker, his wife, for the sum of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00).

(2) That he be empowered and directed as Committee aforesaid, to join in a conveyance of the aforesaid property along with the heirs at law and next of kin of John F. Thompson and Mary V. Thompson, to the said B. E. Walker, Jr., and Audrey M. Walker, his wife.

(3) That the said Charles L. Thompson, Committee, shall make and file a report of his course of action in these proceedings to your Honorable Court.
