

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto the Plaintiff herein an Order of Publication, giving notice to all persons, known and unknown, and whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in the leasehold property and fixtures located on the east side of Walnut Street, in the town and district of Thurmont, County of Frederick, State of Maryland, consisting of a plant located on the leased land assessed in the name of Articaire of Thurmont, commanding them and each of them to appear in this Court on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem the said property, and warning them and each of them, that upon their failure to do so, a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the said property; and also that writs of subpoena be issued directed to Hamilton A. Gale and Lucy D. Gale, his wife, doing business as Articaire of Thurmont, whose last known address was Cheston Avenue, Annapolis, Anne Arundel County, Maryland, to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, and to Horace M. Alexander, Sheriff of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them to be and appear in this Court, either in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.


