The Petition and Report of Sale of Thomas S. Glass, Assignee of
The Thurmont Bank, a body corporate, and Walter R. Jones, Jr., mortgagees
of the Thurmont Flooring and Lumber Company, a body corporate, respect-
fully shows unto your Honors:

1. That the said Thurmont Flooring and Lumber Company, being
indebted unto The Thurmont Bank, a body corporate, in the amount of Fifteen
Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), and unto the Norman Lumber Company, a
body corporate, in the amount of Eleven Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars
(\$11,400.00), executed its promissory note in amount of \$15,000 00 in favor
of The Thurmont Bank, payable one year after date, with interest at the rate
of 5% per annum, and its promissory note in amount of \$11,400.00 in favor of
the Norman Lumber Company, payable one year after date, with interest at
the rate of 5% per annum, all of the right, title and interest of Norman Lumber
Company, Inc. having been assigned by Deed of Assignment dated May 22,
1956 unto Walter R. Jones, Jr., said Deed of Assignment having been recorded
