TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The Petition of John W. Myers, husband of Lillie R. Myers, by Alton Y. Bennett and Sherman P. Bowers, his Solicitors, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That the said Petitioner is the husband of Lillie R. Myers, who has been a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, for many years last past, and they have one child, only, Evelyn Myers Weddle, an adult.

SECOND: That the said Lillie R. Myers is now, and has been for some time last past, of unsound mind and incapable of the management of her person and estate, having been and now confined to Riggs Sanitarium, at Ijamsville, Frederick County, Maryland, having been committed there on December 14, 1956.

THIRD: That your Petitioner has had the said Lillie R. Myers examined by Drs. Joseph Lerner and B. O. Thomas, Sr., medical doctors practicing in the State of Maryland, the former having been in practice five years, and the latter having been in practice in Frederick County more than five years, and herewith files certificates sworn to and subscribed by said doctors as to the cause, nature and extent and probable duration of the incompetency of the said Lillie R. Myers, which said certificates are marked Exhibits "A" and "B" to this Petition and are prayed to be taken and considered as part hereof.

FOURTH: That the estate of the said Lillie R. Myers consists of the following:
