

at 336 North Market Street, which is known as the Edgewood Hotel Property. It is a 3-story ^{brick} building with frame rear addition on the first floor. The third floor is four bedrooms, running water in each room and lavatory. Second floor has four bedrooms with two baths, and the first floor is a lobby and hallway or living room, with two bedrooms on the first floor in the frame addition, with a main bedroom and one bedroom - the one bedroom which Mrs. Myers occupied is on the first floor of the main addition, and there is some storage space, and laundry room and a kitchen and dining room combination. The land and buildings to that property I valued at \$14,500. I might say that the property has no rear entrance. It did at one time. The land was sold off and apparently was no reservation made; so the only entrance is the front and side.

The other property is 335 North Market Street, which is directly across the street, which is operated as an annex to the Edgewood Hotel. That is a 2-story brick property with oil fired steam heating plant with a new furnace unit. That lot has I suppose a 25-foot front and about 100 to 115 feet in depth - I couldn't tell exactly which - other than stepping it off. There are bedrooms and sort of a living room or lounge on the first floor. The second floor has one room with part bath, three rooms with bath. Two rooms have private baths on that floor. That property, land and improvements, I valued at \$11,500.

Then there is at Rocky Hill, beyond Woodsboro, near LeGore, rather, there is a small tract of land - unimproved - which is not too valuable. I thought it was worth probably \$50.00. Just an unimproved tract back from the main road.

Q There is no entrance to that?

A That's right. That covers the real estate.
