ORDER OF COURT.

The above cause standing ready for hearing, testimony was taken in open Court, and being submitted, and the Petition, Exhibits and other papers filed in the cause having been read and considered,

IT IS THEREUPON, this 21st day of June, 1957, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, that Lillie R. Myers be, and she is hereby, declared to be incompetent to manage her estate, and that Evelyn M. Weddle and John W. Myers be, and they are hereby, appointed as Committee to take charge of and manage the property and estate and person of the said Lillie R. Myers, and that the course of their procedure shall be as follows:-

They shall first execute a bond to the State of Maryland, with good and sufficient security, to be approved by this Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) DOLLARS, conditioned that the said Evelyn M. Weddle and John W. Myers, as Committee of the said Lillie R. Myers, will faithfully discharge their duties as such Committee of the said Lillie R. Myers, and deliver up all of the property of the said Lillie R. Myers whenever they may be required by the Order of the Court so to do.

AND it is FURTHER ORDERED that the said Evelyn M. Weddle and John W. Myers, as Committee, return to this Court an Inventory specifically setting forth all property, real and personal, belonging to the estate of the said Lillie R. Myers, and all cash in hand and in bank, -

AND FURTHER that the said Evelyn M. Weddle and John W. Myers, as such Committee, shall render a full and particular account of all the receipts of income and expenditures by them made for and on account of the said estate once in each and every year, or oftener, if so required by the Court.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's taxed costs of this proceeding be paid out of the funds of this estate.
