TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY,  
SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY.

The petition of J. Austin Younkins, a citizen of Frederick County, State of Maryland, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST - That your petitioner is a son of John R. Younkins, the latter being a resident of Frederick County, State of Maryland, and has been such all his life, that the said John R. Younkins is now, and for more than six months last past, has been an habitual drunkard and is not capable of the government of himself or the management of his property and estate.

SECOND - That your petitioner files herewith the affidavits of Doctors Wheeler O. Huff and Bernard O. Thomas, two regularly practicing physicians of Frederick County, State of Maryland, deposing to the truth of the allegations against the said John R. Younkins made in this petition.

THIRD - That the said John R. Younkins is now possessed of a farm consisting of Ninety-six (96) acres, improved with dwelling house and necessary out-buildings situated near Bolivar, in Middletown Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, approximately Seventeen Hundred (\$1700.00) Dollars worth of horses, cattle and farming implements, Twenty (20) acres of growing corn, one practically new Chevrolet Touring Car and other personal property at this time unknown to your petitioner, and that there is no one legally authorized to manage the same for the use, benefit and support of the said John R. Younkins, and that it will be for his benefit to appoint a suitable person, or persons, to manage his person and estate.

Your petitioner therefore prays your Honors that a commission be issued to the Sheriff of Frederick County to inquire into the
