TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Carrie W. Ridgaway, Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of Nettie R. Wood, late of Frederick County, deceased, and as the cestui que trust of the trust estate created therein, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

- 1. That Nettie R. Wood, late of Frederick County, deceased, but temporarily residing, prior to her death, in New York City departed this life on or about the 11th day of December, 1949, leaving a Last Will and Testament dated the 1st day of May, 1941, which said Will was duly admitted to probate in the Orphans Court for Frederick County on the 27th day of December, 1949, and recorded in Liber H. D. R. No. 1, folio 220, one of the Will Books kept in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, a certified copy of which said Will is filled herewith, as a part hereof and marked "Exhibit No. 1" which, together with all other exhibits, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part hereof.
  - 2. That under the terms of said Last Will and Testament it is provided as follows:
    - (11) I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property of every kind and description, real or personal, and wherever situated, unto my sister, Carrie Wood Ridgaway, in trust, to hold the same, with full power to invest, reinvest and change the investments, thereof, and for that purpose or for any other purpose deemed advisable in the administration of said trust, to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any property and investments from time to time held by her as such Trustee; and in further trust to collect the income thereof and, after the payment of all necessary expenses, to distribute the corpus and principal thereof as
