

Q The Union Bridge Banking and Trust Co.?

A That's right, the Union Bridge Banking and Trust Co. against J. Urner Englar, Mrs. Myrtle M. Englar and Margaret T. Englar in the amount of \$950.60.

Q And the interest is paid on that note to what date?

A February 11, 1941.

Q In other words, there is \$950.60 due together with interest from--

A February 11, 1941.

Q I hand you this paper which is marked Exhibit No. 12. Will you tell us what that is?

A This is a renewal of a judgment which the Union Bridge Banking and Trust Co. held against J. Urner Englar, Margaret T. Englar and Myrtle M. Englar, which has been renewed against Myrtle M. Englar, Robert U. Englar, infant, Catherine S. Englar, Donald G. Englar, infant, heirs and terre tenants of J. Urner Englar, deceased, and Margaret T. Englar.

Q What is the amount due on that?

A \$2,212.96.

Q What interest is due on that?

A Interest from February 11, 1941.

Q I hand you this paper marked Exhibit 13 in this proceeding. Will you tell the Court what that is?

A This is a judgment held by the Union Bridge Banking and Trust Company against Margaret T. Englar, J. Urner Englar and Myrtle M. Englar, in the amount of \$1284.98.

Q What is the interest still due on that?

A With interest from March 3, 1941.

Q Mr. Anders, these judgments are a lien against the interest of Margaret T. Englar in this farm and wood lot mentioned in these proceedings?

A They would be a lien against her interest, in my opinion.
