

11. Bernard Lewis, deceased - no children.

12. Betty Leopold, deceased - no children.

*FOURTH:* That said real estate cannot be divided without loss and injury to the parties interested and it is for the benefit and interest of all parties concerned that the same should be sold.

*WHEREFORE,* Your Complainants pray:

(1) That a Trustee be appointed by your Honorable Court for the purpose of selling said real estate.

(2) That after the payment of the costs in these proceedings and the debts of the decedent as proven in the Orphans' Court for Frederick County, that the proceeds therefrom, if any there be, be distributed to the heirs at law of the decedent as their interest may appear.

(3) And for such other and further relief as the case may require.

And the Complainants pray for the following process:

That a Writ of Subpoena may be issued in usual form directed to the following heirs commanding them to be and appear in this Court at some certain day to be named therein and answer the premises and abide by and perform such Decree as may be passed therein, said subpoena to be directed as follows:
