TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

FIRST: That the Bill of Complaint was filed in this cause on September 18, 1957.

Brenton and George Brenton, her husband, were duly summoned to appear on the first Monday of October, 1957.

FOURTH: That the said Defendant, John Wesley Hicks, was returned "Non Est" on October 7, 1957 and again on January 6, 1958.

FIFTH: That the said Defendants have failed to appear either in person or by Solicitor within the time allowed by law and the Plaintiff desires to take testimony to support the allegations of the Bill of Complaint.
