

ORDER OF COURT

It appearing from the proceedings in this cause, that the Defendants, John Francis Nuse and Rebecca Nuse, his wife, Thomas E. Nuse and Wanda Nuse, his wife, Minnie Rebecca Nuse, widow, Margaret Hicks, David William Nuse and Grace Nuse, his wife, Mary B. Fawley and John R. Fawley, her husband, James C. Nuse and Mary Ann Nuse, his wife, Emma Wilson and Ernest W. Wilson, her husband, Dorothy M. French and Arthur B. French, her husband, Catherine I. Brenton and George Brenton, her husband, have been duly summoned, and the said John W. Hicks, has been duly returned "Non Est" twice, and the Order of Publication heretofore issued in this cause has been duly published in "The Post", a newspaper in Frederick County, Maryland, as prescribed by the said Order of Publication issued the 18th day of September, 1957, and the Defendants, the heirs of William Nuse, known and unknown, and John W. Hicks, having failed to appear either in person or by Solicitor according to the exigencies of the said Order of Publication, it is thereupon this 19th day of March, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Sitting as a Court of Equity, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that the Plaintiff is hereby entitled to relief in the premises, and that the Bill of Complaint be and it is hereby taken Pro Confesso against the said Defendants; but because it does not certainly appear to what relief the Plaintiff is entitled, it is further ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that leave be and it is hereby granted to the Plaintiff to take testimony before one of the standing examiners of this Court to support the allegations of the Bill of Complaint in this cause.
