The Petition of the Complainants by Alton Y. Bennett, their Solicitor, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:



3. That a guardian ad litem should be appointed to represent the said infants and lunatic.


Wherefore your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court appoint a guardian ad litem for the said infant Defendants and said lunatic Defendant.
