1. That a Trustee or Trustees be appointed by your Honorable Court for the purpose of selling said real estate.

2. That after the payment of the costs of these proceedings the net proceeds therefrom, if any there be, be distributed to the heirs at law of the decedent as their interests may appear.

3. That an Order of Publication issued, directed to the Non-Resident defendants; directing them and each of them to appear in Court, in person or by solicitor, on some certain date to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why the relief prayed for should not be granted.

4. And for such other and further relief as the case may require.

And your Complainants pray for the following process:

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to Mary Edna Zeigler; residing at 714 N. Market Street, Frederick, Maryland, commanding her to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, and answer the premises and abide by and perform such Decree as may be passed therein.
