By Mr. Sheffield:

Q. Will you state your full name, age and residence?

A. My names is Dorothy M. Pryor, I am 30 years of age and I reside at 4309 Alan Drive, Baltimore 29, Maryland.

Q. What relation, if any were you to William S. Pryor, Jr.?

A. I was the wife of William S. Pryor, Jr., and I am now the widow of William S. Pryor, Jr.,

Q. When did William S. Pryor, Jr., depart from this life?

A. March 7, 1958.

Q. Were you his lawful wife at that time?

A. Yes, I was.

Q. When, where and by whom were you married?

A. We were married at Thurmont, Maryland, By Father Wooden on June 8, 1947.

Q. Was Rev. Wooden a regularly ordained minister of the Gospel?

A. Yes, He was.

Q. As a result of your marriage to the Defendant, William S. Pryor, Jr., was any child or children born?

A. Yes, two children were born, and they are living at the present time.

Q. What is their names and ages?

A. Teresa Ann Pryor, who is nine years of age and Nancy Helene Pryor, who is six years of age.

Q. Are these children in your care and custody at the present time?

A. Yes, they are.

Q. Are they the lawful issue of your marriage to William S. Pryor, Jr.?

A. Yes, they are.

Q. Have they been in your care and custody since birth?

A. Yes, they have been.

Q. Have you had a legal guardian appointed for these children subsequent to the death of your husband, William S. Pryor, Jr.?
