DECREE PRO CONFESSO

The Defendants, Irene Potts Riggs, Lewis Calvin James, Laura Almedia James Essex, Margaret Virginia James Jenkins and William Henry James, having been duly summoned to appear and answer to the Bill of Complaint, and having failed to do so within the time limited by law; and the known non-resident defendants and any and all unknown resident or non-resident defendants, as well as any other unknown heirs or persons, whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, interested or claiming to be interested in these proceedings, or the land mentioned herein, having been given notice of the object and substance of the Bill of Complaint and having failed to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the time limited in said Order of Publication,

It is thereupon this 2nd day of July, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the Complainants are entitled to relief in the premises and that the Bill be taken as confessed against said defendants, but because it does not certainly appear to what relief the Complainants are entitled, it is further ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that leave be granted to the Complainants to take testimony before this Court, or one of its Standing Examiners, to support the allegations of the Bill.
