IT IS THEREUPON, This 21st day of February, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County aforesaid, in Equity, and by the authority thereof, ORDERED that the said Complainant may, and he is hereby authorized to, amend the Bill of Complaint, by adding as Defendants the persons whose names are set forth in the foregoing Petition, namely, Thomas Hopkins, Philadelphia, Pa.; Edward Hopkins, New Market, Md.; and the said Petitioner, William O. Lee, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice by publication to all persons, whether they be residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, who may be entitled to share in the partition as prayed or whose rights may be affected by distribution under said partition proceedings, advising of the substance of the Bill of Complaint and warning all such persons to be and appear in this Court by a day therein stated, which shall not be less than 30 days after the passage of the Order as herein prayed, and further advising that, after the expiration of such period fixed in said Order for appearance the Court will proceed to act as in other Equity cases where the Defendants have been summoned, and according to Law (Art. 16, secs. 155-171, Code of Maryland, 1951).
