

County, being No. 67 Trials, May Term, 1938, in the principal sum of \$6,600.00, interest from October 4, 1934, together with costs of said judgment and plus the further sum of 10% on principal amount of judgment as attorney's fees for collection, said judgment being entitled "Commercial Bank of Frederick, Md., now known as Commercial Bank of Maryland, a body corporate, to the use of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp., (plaintiff) Vs. Ida M. Markey, et al." all of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to a certified copy of said judgment filed with said original bill of complaint as "Plaintiff's Judgment Exhibit No. 7"; that the said Ida M. Markey was indebted unto divers other persons and corporations, the names of which are unknown to this plaintiff; that the plaintiff's claim represented by the aforesaid judgment set forth in Paragraph 4 of the original and amended bill of complaint is a lien on the lands and premises herein described and is entitled to a preference in the distribution of the estate of said decedent over all other claims except any claims which might be valid prior liens on said real estate; that the personal estate of the said Ida M. Markey is greatly insufficient to pay her debts and it will be necessary that the real estate hereinbefore described be sold for the payment of this plaintiff's, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, judgment debt hereinbefore described, as well as for the payment of all other debts of said decedent; and your plaintiff further represents that it has been credibly informed and therefore avers that in fact the said personal estate is wholly insufficient to pay the debts of the said Ida M. Markey, deceased, as aforesaid; that there are three judgments unreleased, and of record in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court for Frederick County among the judgment records of said Court against one of the defendants, namely D. John Markey, as follows: (1) Frederick County National Bank, a corporation, Vs. D. John Markey and Edna Markey, his wife, ren-
