A Those two parcels, yes.

Q Did Everett ever say to you in the presence of George or James that he had bought the premises from James?

(Mr. DeLauter) Objected to in its form, of either George or James.

A No.

Q Do you recall the period of time when Everett bought the property from James?

A No, I don't, but it was some time after.

Q By that do you mean you don't recall the year?

A No.

Q Do you remember whether or not James was employed at the time?

A I don't believe he was at the time.
