THE ANSWER OF ELMER C. STERNER

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Answer of Elmer C. Sterner, one of the heirs at law, devisees, descendants and successors of John Loats, deceased, Defendant, by Leroy W. Preston, his solicitor, to the bill of complaint of The Loats Female Orphan Asylum of Frederick City, in the County of Frederick, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, filed against him and others in this Court and answering the same herein respectfully says:

1. That John Loats died on December 29, 1889 leaving surviving him as his only heirs at law, ten children of whom one was Mary A. Sterner who died in the year 1901 leaving surviving her four children among whom was Alfred L. Sterner, Sr. who died on February 1, 1952 leaving surviving him as his only heirs at law six children among whom one is your Respondent, the said Elmer C. Sterner, who now resides at 4065 South Hazel Court, Englewood, Colorado; furthermore, your Respondent says that he is a direct descendant and one of the heirs of John Loats, deceased, and files his answer herein pursuant to the order of publication of this Honorable Court dated October 31, 1957 wherein the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of John Loats, deceased, were sued.

2. That he admits all the matters and facts set forth and alleged in the first paragraph of said bill of complaint, excepting the allegation that the Plaintiff has been the owner of the land therein described, which he
