2. That they admit the allegations contained in the second, third, fourth and fifth paragraphs of said Bill.

3. That your Respondents admit the matters and facts set forth and contained in the sixth paragraph of said Bill and further answering said paragraph say:

That the last named John Loats, deceased, died on December 29, 1889, leaving surviving him, as his only heirs at law, ten children, namely, (A) Edward L. Loats, (B) Clarence Loats, (C) Mary A. Sterner, (D) Ross Loats, (E) Florence Wilhelm, (F) Franklin Loats, (G) Harvey Loats, (H) Harry A. Loats, (I) Margaret Stabler and (J) Laura K. Sterner.

A. That the said Edward Loats died on October 29, 1918, leaving surviving him, as his only heirs at law, two children, namely, Bertie Hobbs, who resides at 3609 Dudley Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, and Ethel V. Kelly, who resides at 2115 North Fulton Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, both of whom are Respondents herein.

B. That the said Clarence Loats died in the year 1945 leaving no issue.

C. That the said Mary A. Sterner died in the year 1901, leaving surviving her, as her only heirs at law, the following children, namely, (1) Lydia S. Davis, one of the Respondents herein, who resides at 4017 Evans Chapel Road, Baltimore, Maryland; (2) Lottie S. McCartin, one of the Respondents herein, who resides at 3437 Pleasant Place, Baltimore, Maryland; (3) Sadie Schafer, one of the Respondents herein, who resides at 4011 Evans Chapel Road, Baltimore, Maryland and (4) Alfred L. Sterner who died on February 1, 1952, leaving surviving him as his only heirs at law, the following children, namely:

(a) Alfred L. Sterner, Jr., who resides at 3975 Santa Fe Drive, Englewood, California;

(b) Frederick W. Sterner, one of the Respondents herein, who resides at 3824 Elm Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland;
