1. That at the time of the death of Mary Roberta Wagner a one-fifth interest in the fee simple properties and in the leasehold property mentioned in these proceedings was vested in said Mary Roberta Wagner.

3. That, as your Petitioner, in her individual capacity, is a party plaintiff in this case, it is proper that your Petitioner, as Administratrix of the Estate of Mary Roberta Wagner, be made a party plaintiff herein.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that an order may be passed by this Honorable Court making your Petitioner a party plaintiff herein.
